A Peek At What We Are Learning



READING

ON – Students will recount stories, including fables and folktales, from diverse cultures and determine their central message, lesson, or moral. They will also describe how characters in a story respond to major events and challenges. They will identify the main topic of a multi-paragraph text as well as the focus of specific paragraphs within the text. We will also work on identifying the main purpose of a text, including what the author wants to answer, explain, or describe. They will also compare and contrast the most important points presented by two texts on the same topic.

ACC - Students will continue to focus on literary reading.



WRITING

Students will focus on writing realistic fiction stories (stories that **could** have occurred to people or animals in a believable setting). They will include characters, a setting, and a problem and solution. They will also include details to describe actions, thoughts, and feelings, use transition words to put the story in order, and provide a sense of closure.



MATH

ON – Students are working through our place value unit. They are reviewing skills from first grade and applying them to the second grade standards. They are also working on skip counting, comparing numbers, and different forms of numbers.

ACC- Students will finish their multiplication and division unit. Then students will move into applying multiplication and division. Students will work on solving two-step words problems and patterns in arithmetic.



SOCIAL STUDIES/ SCIENCE

We finished our unit on the Georgia Regions. We will be moving on to our first science unit about the states of matter.
